#### **NOTICE OF RACE**

**II PUERTO PORTALS DRAGON WINTER SERIES, WHICH CONSISTS IN FOUR EVENTS, WILL BE HELD IN PUERTO PORTALS SEA WATERS FROM 26<sup>th</sup> OCTOBER 2018 TO 20<sup>th</sup> JANUARY 2019.**

#### **1. ORGANIZATION**

II Puerto Portals Dragon Winter Series sailing race is organized by Club de Regatas Puerto Portals (CRPP) with the collaboration of the International Dragon Association, Asociación Española de Dragones and Federación Balear de Vela.

#### **2. VENUE AND DATES**

The race will take place in Puerto Portals sea waters on the following dates:

#### **3. RULES**

The sailing race will be governed by:

- Rules as defined in The Race rules of Sailing of the WORLD SAILING 2017-2020.
- Prescriptions of the RFEV to RRV 2017-2020.

- The Dragon Race rules.
- Sailing Race Equipment rules of the WORLD SAILING 2017-2020.

3.1. In case of any discrepancy between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions take precedence.

3.2. In case of any discrepancy between the English and Spanish Notice, Spanish Notice takes precedence.



#### 4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1. Only International Dragon Class yachts holding valid measurement certificates shall compete.
- 4.2. Persons in charge of boats shall be up to date members of their National Dragon association.
- 4.3. All boats shall register. Registration will take place on the dates and times stated in point 7 of this NoR. Entry will finalizes on completion of registration.

#### 5. ADVERTISING

- 5.1. Participants may display advertisement in accordance with Regulation 20 of the WORLD SAILING, competition rules of the Real Spanish Sailing Federation and Pre-inscriptions of the Real Spanish Sailing Federation with such Regulation.
- 5.2. Participants may be required to display advertisement in accordance with regulation 20.3.1 (d) (i) of the WORLD SAILING. Any rule of class that opposes this prevision will be modified.
- 5.3. Any advertisement will be regulated by the Dragon class.
- 5.4. Organizers reserve the right to require the elimination or substitution of any kind of advertisement that, in their opinion, does not comply with moral and ethical rules of general acceptance. (Regulation 20 of the WORLD SAILING).
- 5.5. In case of uncertainty, it is recommended that ship owners ask for approval as soon as possible and always before the registration deadline.

#### 6. ENTRIES

- 6.2. Inscriptions fees will consist in two packages A and B. Participants have to choose one of them.

## 7. REGISTRATION

7.1. Skippers will be asked to fill and sign the Registry Form at the Organizing Club Offices every starting day of all sailing races.



7.2. The following documents are mandatory before the deadline for a successful registration:

- a. Proof of inscription payment
- b. Boat's paperwork
- c. Federated Sailing License of the RFEV or corresponding federation of participants and Crew.
- d. Insurance document
- e. The office of secretary is the competent authority to be aware of payments. To these effects the National Association will send to the Organizing Committee a list of all those members who at the deadline of registration are up to date in the payment of their dues to the Association
- f. Participants from other Nationalities have to present an equivalent document of their National Authority affiliation member of the WORLD SAILING of their country and also the Civil Liability Insurance document, legally translated into Spanish, for the equivalent amount that Spanish Federative License covers
- g. Photocopy of national identity document or Passport

7.3. Handover of Sailing Instructions will be delivered once the registration has been formalized in the Race Offices, according to point 8.2. of this Sailing Race Announcement.

## 9. SCORING

10.1. The rating applied will be The Low Score System provided in Appendix A4 of the RRV WORLD SAILING 2017-2020. No score will be excluded.

## 10. PRIZES

10.1. Prizes will be awarded to the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> classified.

10.2. Prize will be awarded to the 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthian and 1<sup>st</sup> Classic.

## 11. CORINTHIAN DIVISION AND TROPHY

11.1. The Corinthian Trophy will be awarded to the helmsman of the winning boat in the Corinthian Division of the Puerto Portals Dragon Winter Series. It is necessary to specify in the registration form.

11.2. For the Corinthian Division and Trophy the World Sailing Sailor Classification Code, Regulation 22 shall apply and all crew shall hold a valid Group 1 classification. Unclassified sailors will be deemed to be Group 3.

11.3. A boat entered in the Corinthian Division for the Corinthian Trophy shall also be entered automatically in the Open Division and shall be eligible for prizes and trophies in both divisions.

11.4. The closing date for the receipt of valid Corinthian entries shall be at the time of registration. Each entry shall include a complete crew list and show the classification, World Sailing. I/D number and classification expiry date for each crew.

11.5. All crew shall hold valid classifications prior to this date that do not expire until after the final day of the regatta. Should a boat whose Corinthian entry has been checked and accepted need to change a crew member between the closing date of the entry and the start of the regatta, the name of the new crew member with their valid World Sailing I/D number must be submitted to the Organizing Authority for their approval.

11.6. The Classification Protest Time Limit is the end of protest time on the first day racing.

11.7. Only participants who have participated in the entire Puerto Portals Dragon Winter Series (4 events) as a Corinthian will be entitled to a trophy.

## 12. LIABILITY

12.1. Everyone participate in the race on their own risk and responsibility.

12.2. The Organizing committee or any other organization involved with the event will not be held responsible for any physical, personal damages or losses which may affect people or others, whether in sea or in land, as a consequence of participation of any sailing race covered in this sailing announcement and will be under the entire responsibility of the participants.

12.3. Please note the fundamental rule 4, decision of racing, part of the RRV, which States:

**“A boat is solely responsible for its decision whether or not to take the start or not to continue in the race.”**



### **13. SAFETY**

13.1. The safety of this race is considered category 4, in accordance with the Special Rules of Racing on the high seas of the WORLD SAILING.

13.2. Participants are committed to carry on board, under their responsibility, the regulatory documentation of the vessel up to date as well as the proper certification and equipment for the management and navigation of the vessel.

### **14. INSURANCE**

14.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 1.500.000€ per event or the equivalent.

### **15. MOORINGS**

14.1. Accepted inscriptions in this Sailing Race will have free of charge mooring during the event. Participants belonging to **package A** will be able to "stay on land" from the **1<sup>st</sup> of October 2018 until the 28<sup>th</sup> of February 2019**. Only 20 slots will be available for the shore docking.

Participants inscribed in **package B** will have free of charge mooring two days before and after the event.

### **15. SUPPORT BOATS**

15.1. Support boats of participants must be registered in the Organizing Club Office. Mooring request has to be made in the same office before the 1<sup>st</sup> of October 2018.

### **16. RACING COMMUNICATIONS**

16.1. The Race committee will use channel 69 to communicate during the celebration of the races.

16.2. All participating vessels may be fitted with a VHF operating radio.

### **17. SOCIAL EVENTS**

17.1. All Social Events will be published in the O.N.B (official notice board) and/or in the Instructions of Sailing Race.

### **18. SAILING INSTRUCCIONS**

18.1. The Sailing Instructions (SI) will be available to the registered yachts at the Race Office from October 25<sup>th</sup>

### **19. CHANGES TO THE NOTICE**

18.1. The organization reserves the right to modify this Notice of Race. Any change made to this Notice of Race will be published in the O.N.B. (official notice board).
